Sir:

Your Committee on Municipal, County and Civil Service, to which was referred House Bill No. 336, entitled: "An Act to amend chapter 80 of the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1935, as amended by Act 182 of the Session Laws of Hawaii 1935, as amended by Act 169 of the Session Laws of Hawaii 1939, relating to license fees of peddlers," introduced by Representative Kam Tai Lee, begs leave to report as follows:

Under the present law no license fee is required of a citizen of the territory 70 years old or more.

The purpose of this bill is to amend section 2498 of the Revised Laws of Hawaii 1935, as amended, by deleting the phrase requiring a license fee of a citizen of the territory 70 years old or more.

Your committee is in accord with the provisions of this bill and therefore recommends its passage.
